Write a JavaScript program that first prompts for a person's name. Then, the program inspects the last letter of the name. If the letter is an *a*, the program guesses that it is a girl's name. If not, it guesses that it is a boy's name. Output must be a complete sentence following all rules of English. (Note that this program will guess incorrectly frequently, because many girls' names don't end in *a*.)

You may earn 10 extra points if your program can detect that names ending in *ah, ie, ine, is, ene, een, lle, que, th, x, or y* are female, but *Henry* is male.

This program must be demonstrated as working by Thursday, March 17.
